#### INTRODUCTION

In the New Testament we find that discipleship was based on a call by Jesus. It involved personal allegiance to Him, expressed in following Him and giving Him an exclusive loyalty.

# INTRODUCTION

In some cases it meant literal abandonment of home, business ties and possessions. However, in every case it is readiness to put the claims of Jesus first, whatever the cost, was demanded. Such an attitude gave the word 'disciple' a new sense. Faith in Jesus and allegiance to Him are what determine the fate of men at the last judgement [Mark 10:30; Luke 12:8].

### WHAT IS A DISCIPLE?

A disciple of Christ is someone who seeks to follow the teachings of Jesus and the life He modeled for us through:

- A deepening knowledge of God and the Bible
- A growing personal relationship with God and others
- A life of faith that is evident to those around us

# WHAT IS A DISCIPLE?

Discipleship is The life long process of growing in Christ-likeness as we seek to:

- Know God
- Love God
- Serve God

# WHAT IS A DISCIPLE?

Leadership is Discipleship Kicked up a notch. It is discipleship that has progressed to the point where the disciple is spiritually prepared and equipped to guide others along in the journey we know as the Christian life.

• You must be Intentional About Planning for Transformation Making

Disciples requires that you be intentional about planning for transformation. There are people who have amassed a great deal of head knowledge, not a life change.

• Be Intentional About Planning for Transformation

Attend bible study and learn as much as you can about the Word of God. But also learn how to translate information into transformation. This can only be accomplished thru the Holy Spirit who will lead and guide you into all truth.

Build Time For Reflection

Take time immediately after serving in a ministry event or project and ask yourself some thought provoking questions, such as:

- What went right today?
- How and where did you sense God working?
- Specifically, how did God use you?
- What impact does that have on your faith?
- What is your next step?

#### Build Time For Reflection

Be sure to spend some time in prayer, thanking God for what has happened and for allowing you to be part of the work of God's ministry. Taking the time to reflect will bring meaning to the tasks you are about; it will also have an impact on your spiritual growth. You will then start to make connections between your faith and your service to God.

Seek To Follow The Teachings of Christ

A disciple of Christ is someone who seeks to follow the teachings of Jesus and the life He modeled for us through a deepening knowledge of God.

- Love God with your heart
- Show a life of faith that is evident to those around you
